









Welcome Back, Porter County!

In 2021, PCPLS welcomed over **330,000 visitors** into our facilities.

- Our branches were open nearly **15,000 hours**, a 25% increase over 2020.
- PCPLS issued 6,223 new library cards in 2021.

8,579 people used our meeting rooms 2,916 times - an increase of 56% over 2020.

Porter County residents provided PCPLS with over 1,200 volunteer hours.

Financial Highlights



PCPLS supports our local economies.

- 47% of expenditures went back into Porter County
- 54% of expenditures stayed within Lake, Porter, and La Porte Counties
- 54% of all expenditures were put back into the State of Indiana

By providing over 400,000 physical and 900,000 electronic items, PCPLS saved Porter County residents a total of over \$20,968,431 - a per capita savings of at least \$145.

We invested over **\$1.2 million** into PCPLS' facilities in 2021, including crucial HVAC upgrades systemwide, repairs to Hebron's entrance stairs, replacing Valparaiso's and Portage's roofs, and more.

Technology Highlights



- 40,741 patrons used PCPLS computers for a total of 24,622 hours in 2021.
- Our website was accessed over 227,000 times.
- Our eNewsletter reaches over 15,000 people monthly.

- Through social media, we reached over 445,000 people.
- Our 30 databases were accessed nearly 200,000 times.

Outreach by the numbers:

- PCPLS staff reached over 21,000 people at 56 outreach events in 2021. This is an attendance increase of 669%!
- Staff interacted with over 6,000 people at the 2021 Porter County Fair!

Programming Highlights





2021 saw the Grand Opening of Valparaiso's Rotary Library Garden, a beautiful setting for programming and community events.

In 2021, **36,307** community members attended **632** PCPLS programs - a **68%** increase from 2020.

Reading challenges inspired community members to relax with a good book.

- 3,061 patrons participated in 4 reading challenges.
- Summer Reading participants read a total of 25,750 books.
- Pages for Pizza and Cozy Winter Challenge participants read for a total of 151,512 minutes or 2,525 hours.
